

Heath Band Booster Meeting Minutes 1/12/22

Meeting opened 6:29 pm

Old Business

Vertical 196 donation from the Chili Bake Off – Vicki will drop off.

Banners from Football – Vicki and Marissa will clean and get ready to store until next football season. Will place in band room storage

Pep Band – No changes in schedule. Students are required to attend 5 games to be eligible to attend hockey game. Mr. Martin is trying to contact OSU to get info for attending/playing at OSU hockey game. Vicki also suggested looking into going to Columbus Blue Jacket game if unable to make arrangements with OSU. Estimated number of students to attend game 20-25.

Craft Show – Total profit \$865.14 Discussed making this a yearly fundraiser. Also scheduling multiple craft nights to make items to be sold. Also discussed keeping items with Heath theme.

Uniforms – Old uniforms have all been collected and accounted for. Vicki will call cleaners for pickup of the uniforms to be cleaned in the event that new uniforms will not be received in time for the next marching band season.

Fall or Holiday party/potluck – Parent's Night Out at Roosters was a nice success. Discussed having another in the spring/fall for meet and greet for new parents.

Holiday Concert – Donations received \$710.00 and food. Food will be boxed up at the end of meeting and Vicki will drop off at the Food Pantry tomorrow.

Treasurers Report

Checking account- \$8,865.26

Savings account - \$5,000.00

Discussed moving more of the money to savings and keeping \$5000.00 in checking. Unanimous vote to do this.

New Business

Banner Letters – Form committee to get banner letters printed, addressed, and sent out to local businesses. Typically send out to 50 local businesses. Needs to be completed by end of May. Discussed using sign up genius to form committee. Mr. Martin will put info in newsletter.

Fundraiser - Mr. Martin played video explaining SNAP fundraiser. This fundraiser would require participants to send out email/text/Facebook/QR code to family/friends to ask for donations to the Band. It would run for 30 days. It could be an annual fundraiser and build

each year as participants can be contacted each year if they choose to. 20% of donations would be taken by SNAP. Funds then would be sent to Mr. Martin's school account. Mr. Martin will check with Carl about having funds deposited to his school account as it cannot be sent to the Band Booster account. Tentative date for the fundraiser 1/21 – 2/24

Candy Bar Fundraiser – Start date February 11. Vicki will come in Friday 2/11 to help disperse candy bars to students. Candy bars need to be ordered at least a week before sale starts.

April Fundraiser – Egg your yard for Easter. Plastic eggs filled with candy – person purchases 25, 50, or 100 to be placed in yard. Band students place eggs in yards. Need to start earlier to get supplies needed.

New Uniforms – Mr. Martin shared uniform prototype with Boosters. Uniforms need to be ordered ASAP. Currently if ordered in February, should be received in September with current timeline given to Mr. Martin.

President – announcement of resignation – Vicki has officially given her resignation as of the end of school year, May 2022. Mr. Martin thanked Vicki for all her hard work and assistance with the band boosters. Election of new officers will happen in May and we will need to try to talk with parents of band members to try to get more involvement and hopefully some new booster members/officers.
